- Adult males 18+
- Completing detox or residential treatment
- Active in outpatient (IOP / HIOP / OP)
- Drug court / probation / reentry
- Committed to sobriety
- Able to pay weekly/monthly rent
- MAT-friendly with valid prescription

### What we require of residents

- Zero tolerance for alcohol and drugs
- Compliance with curfew
- Random drug/EtG alcohol testing
- 3 recovery meetings per week
- Active employment or treatment engagement
- Respect for community standards

### Clinical independence

*Nova is a housing provider only. We do not provide clinical services, however we have preferred community treatment partners. Residents choose their own treatment program. We welcome referrals from any licensed provider.*
